## **PROCLAMATION**

## Recognizing the First Wednesday of October as Energy Efficiency Day

WHEREAS, energy efficiency continues to be the cheapest, quickest, and cleanest way to meet our energy needs and reduce utility bills for residential, business, and industrial customers in our community; and

WHEREAS, energy efficiency can also make our homes and workspaces healthier, safer, and more comfortable; and

WHEREAS, implementing energy efficiency and other clean energy policies and programs can help boost economic opportunities and job creation while continuing to move toward a sustainable future; and

WHEREAS, a nationwide network of energy efficiency groups and partners has designated the first Wednesday in October as national annual Energy Efficiency Day; and

WHEREAS, together, the residents of Will County can continue to contribute to our sustainability efforts by learning more about energy efficiency and practicing smarter energy use in their daily lives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Will County Board and Will County Executive hereby proclaim the first Wednesday of October 2022 as Energy Efficiency Day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Will County Board and the Will County Executive urge citizens, agencies, and other organizations to recommit to strengthening our energy security and to using our energy resources responsibly to continue on a path toward energy independence.
